The Chairperson of the Board of Fire Commissioner read the following statements to the public:

This is the public hearing regarding the 2024 proposed budget. In accordance with New York State Town Law, all Fire Districts must, prior to the adoption of their budget, hold a public hearing on their budget. This budget hearing must be held in such a manner to maximize participation in the budget process. The purpose of this hearing is to discuss the contents of the budget. The Board of Fire Commissioners in accordance with legal requirements has adopted their proposed budget on the 12th day of September, 2023 (Resolution 2023-072), which is 35 days prior to this budget hearing.

The Secretary of the Fire District has filed with this District an affidavit stating that the notice of this public hearing was at published and posted Oct 5, 2023 as follows:

The purpose of this public hearing is to allow members of the public to make comments on the budget. Any person may be heard in favor of, or against, the preliminary budget or any item in it. Please note that this is only a proposed budget until the Board of Fire Commissioners adopts the final budget.

Prior to the public comment portion of this budget hearing, I will make a brief presentation about the preliminary budget to the Board of Fire Commissioners and members of the public who are present. The Chairman will not answer questions during the presentation as this is not intended to be a question-and-answer session.

This budget must be adopted no later than November 4, and submitted to the Town Supervisor by November 7.

The public comment period begins: I will now ask any person present wishing to be heard on this proposed budget to come forward so that that person may be heard in favor of, or against, the proposed budget or any item in it. Clearly state your name and address for the record. Please limit your comments to five (5) minutes. Please direct all your questions to the Board or the Treasurer. This is not a question-and-answer session. Your question will not be answered when asked. The Board is looking for your opinion on the budget or any part of it, whether favorable or not. Please tell us what you are in favor of regarding this budget or what you are against. You may ask questions, but this board and the treasurer will not answer any questions until the conclusion of the public comments period.
